## Pop-eye



The symptom of protruding eyes might be caused by various disorders. Fluid build-up behind the eye is probably one of the more common causes, but flukes and TB are other conditions that result in the eyes being distended in the same way. Although not reckoned to be highly contagious, there is a risk that if the affected fish dies in with other healthy fish, flukes or TB could be passed on from the corpse being picked and pecked at as potential food for others. With this in mind, the removal of the fish to a quarantine tank for treatment is advisable. If the onset of the problem can be related to poor conditions of the water, feeding or other stressful factors, it might correct itself once the conditions are improved.
